**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

1. Highlights of accomplishments for the day include conduct of activities that support the following outcomes: Technology adoption promoted and accelerated; Productivity and efficiency of communities and the production sector, particularly MSMEs, improved; Resiliency to disaster risks and climate change ensured; and, Effective STI governance achieved.
2. Project monitoring and capability-building activities in relation to the Small Enterprise Technology Upgrading Program (SETUP), Science for Change Program (S4CP), and other regional Local Grants-in-Aid (GIA) and Community-based Enterprise projects were also conducted.
3. Project mobilization activities in some geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas (GIDA) were conducted in partnership with local stakeholders from the local government units (LGUs), state universities and colleges (SUCs), and the industry.
